Code of Conduct

MUN Team University of Zurich

I. Appliance and Precondition

1. The Code of Conduct¹ for the Model United Nations Team University of Zurich² applies to all its Members that are part of a delegation to a national or international conference.
2. Team Members agree to the following as a precondition of participation in the Association's activities:
 - a. Delegates represent the Association and thereby its reputation. Their behavior has to be tailored to this accountability.
 - b. Any form of disrespectful behavior towards people or material, alcohol abuse and further actions of misconduct shall not be tolerated. Delegates may not embark on any action amounting to sexual harassment.

II. National and International Conferences

3. Members joining a delegation to a conference are to respect deadlines imposed on them during the preparation process. They are responsible for a timely submission of the requested material (e.g. personal information, position papers) and expected to participate in all preparatory events.
4. Delegates will attend every Committee Session and mandatory activity of the conference. Exceptions may be granted by the Head Delegate in extraordinary cases.
5. Delegates are expected to be punctual to all sessions and events and respect the decisions of the Head Delegate.
6. Delegates are advised to announce a cancellation of their participation as early as possible to the Chief Head Delegate. In case a binding reservation or payment for the Delegate or delegation, e.g. for travel or accommodation, has already been made prior to the notification by the Delegate, he or she is obliged to pay the full share of costs.

7. Delegates are expected to attend all of the Association's Weekly Sessions from when they are accepted into the delegation until the end of the academic semester. Exceptions to this rule are only granted two times. More than two sessions may only be missed under special circumstances, to be recognized as such by the Chief Head Delegate. If a Delegate does not adhere to this rule, the Association reserves the right to charge the Delegate for the costs incurred preliminarily by the Association.
8. Members joining a delegation are bound to the "Reglement zur Rückerstattung von Ausgaben" and the "Spesenreglement".

III. Final Notes

9. The MUN Team University of Zurich declines any responsibility for its Members' behavior. Each Delegate is responsible for his or her own individual actions and neither the Team, nor its Executive Board, will take over any kind of liability.
10. Breaches of this Code will be discussed by the Executive Board and may lead to the exclusion from a delegation or the Association as a whole and will exclude from any claims for financial reimbursement.
